- ACRA has been set up with the organizational and governing structure including a General Assembly, Board of Directors, and elected a General Secretary and Board Chair.

- Members of OESPAAA working with 12 countries those are members of this association – Colombo Process
- Partner with the government (such as ministry of labour & Vocational training and ministry of interior) and embassies on anti-human trafficking, worker protection, worker legalization, consultation)
- Partner with other NGO such as IOM and ILO on skills development for unskilled workers and skills recognition
- Training to recruiters and its members on legal statutes for recruitment and safe migration



Code of Conduct

Malpractice, Moral and Social responsibility are our concern. ACRA has approved the Code of Conduct for its members in January 2009 (Supported by UNIFEM/UNWOMEN).
